## New Features / Enhancements

The following new features or enhancements have been introduced with this release

Ref ID	New Feature / Enhancement Description
1	<i>PMI Processing:</i> Improved Creo PMI processing has been added for Creo 2.0 and Creo 3.0
2	<i>View Combinations:</i> View combinations are now supported for Creo 2.0 and Creo 3.0
3	<i>Updated API Support:</i> Hoops v8.1 libraries have been adopted
4	<i>PDF File Size:</i> Files containing PMI are now smaller in size
5	<i>PDF Table Enhancements:</i> BOM and Instance tables now support top level Nodes (REQ00132)  Text Size, RGB and justification controls have been added
6	<i>Auto File Suffix:</i> PDF files are now auto-named with the .pdf suffix
7	<i>Semantic PMI:</i> Semantic PMI attributes are added into the PDF file definition
8	<i>Level of Detail:</i> level of detail now defaults to Medium which produces smaller files with no degradation in quality. 'ultra_low' also added as an option.
9	<i>Hidden Wireframe:</i> Hidden wireframe is now not processed by default
10	<i>Publishing Template Updates:</i> Templates now support: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Centre of Rotation button option</li> <li>• Enhanced user interaction via flexible javaScript utilities</li> <li>• Scroll / 3D / Assembly /Property Panel interaction</li> <li>• Scroll table scroll bar</li> <li>• Enhanced table row filtering</li> <li>• Digital Signature</li> </ul>
11	<i>PDF Document Properties:</i> Title, Author and Subject can now be specified (REQ00147)
12	<i>View Optimization:</i> View zoom factors are optimized and can be controlled by user selection. In addition improvements have been made to the clipping of models within views, ensuring the near and far clipping planes allow for the model size.
13	<i>Mirrored Components:</i> Mirrored components with no scaling are now supported



14	<i>Small PMI:</i> Very small PMI objects (<3mm) previously appeared very course. Now resolved.
15	<i>PMI Edge Associations:</i> PMI edge highlighting is now supported. This can be disabled via the <i>'no_pmi_edge_associations'</i> option
16	<i>Configuration Options:</i> The precedence of command line arguments and configuration file arguments can now be set
17	<i>View Grouping:</i> By default the geometry for each view is grouped into a single node. A secondary method has been made available ( <i>'view_geom_exploded'</i> ) that creates a node for each referenced geometric item. In some cases this can produce a faster translation and smaller files size, dependent upon how many views there are and how much geometry is shared between views
18	<i>Robustness Improvements:</i> General robustness improvements have been made
19	<p><i>Section Properties:</i> Control of the following section properties have been added (REQ00153):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cutting Plane Visibility</li> <li>• Capping Visibility</li> <li>• Cutting Plane Intersections Visibility</li> <li>• Cutting Plane Opacity</li> <li>• Cutting Plane Colour</li> <li>• Cutting Plane Intersections Colour</li> </ul>
20	<i>Instance Table Sequence Numbers:</i> Added support for Instance Table sequence numbers (REQ00131)
21	<i>Standard View Names:</i> Standard View prefixes are now controlled via the manifest file (REQ00128)
22	<i>Configurable Selection Box Part Names:</i> Users can now elect which property is to be used to display as a Part Name in the selection box (REQ00120)
23	<i>Publish 3D Interactive:</i> The Interactive User Menus have been improved to be consistent with standard PTC Creo menus.





## Known Limitations and Restrictions

The following limitations and restrictions have been identified during final testing prior to release

Ref ID	Limitations and Restrictions
1	<p><i>Help Shortcut:</i> The Help short-cut points to &lt;install_dir\help.html. This redirects to the latest help on the web site at <a href="http://www.theorem.com/Documentation">http://www.theorem.com/Documentation</a>. There is, however, no short-cut to the help shipped on the CD, which can be accessed at: &lt;install_dir\Guides\NX_3DPDF_index.htm</p>
2	<p><i>PMI Flipping:</i> PDF does not support flipped PMI</p>
3	<p><i>Unified Interface Viewer Export:</i> When exporting from the Unified Interface, the output name uses the top level assembly name by default, regardless of selection. This can be overridden via the <i>Translator Options-&gt;Confirmation</i> panel</p>
4	<p><i>Unified Interface Viewer:</i> The Unified Interface Viewer does not display PMI at the assembly level</p>
5	<p><i>Unified Interface Viewer:</i> There is no option to export the entire assembly from the Viewer, when nothing is selected</p>
6	<p><i>Wildfire 5.0 PMI:</i> There are API limitations with reading Wildfire 5.0 PMI data so:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No views are exported to pdf from WF5</li> <li>• Rendered PMI cannot be read, so a stroked interpretation is provided for Wildfire 5.0 PMI</li> <li>• Wildfire 5.0 does not support the setting of Output Directory in the Interactive pulldown list of directories</li> </ul>
7	<p><i>PMI Leader Lines:</i> Intermittent issues have been noted that sometimes cause PMI leader lines to be omitted.</p>
8	<p><i>PMI Processing:</i> Interactive processing of views and PMI, for Creo 2.0 and Creo 3.0, results in some unavoidable screen activity.</p> <p>The active model will cycle through the view states (where these exist) and a “PMI regeneration” message will flash on the screen repeatedly until ALL PMI is processed.</p> <p>There is currently no way to suppress this action.</p>
